

Healing heARTs Matching Game Project  
Design a fun matching game to play again and again!

Materials Provided:

24 Wooden Discs (+ 2 extras)  
12 Pairs of Matching Sticker Circles (+ 54 extra pairs)  
1 White Box

Instructions:

- 1) We suggest watching our easy video instructions at [www.hharts.org](http://www.hharts.org).
- 2) Look through all of the stickers and choose 12 different sticker circles. Peel off a sticker circle and stick it on a wooden disc (center the sticker on the disc). Make sure that the sticker lines up with the wooden disc, so that it is not visible from the other side of the disc. Repeat with the other 11 stickers. These are your first 12 game pieces.
- 3) Look through the leftover stickers to find the 12 sticker circles that match your first 12 game pieces. Repeat Step 2 with these 12 matching stickers and 12 more wooden discs.
- 4) Use leftover stickers to decorate the white box or for another project.
- 5) Store your game pieces in the white box.
- 6) The object of the game is to collect the most matching pairs. To set up the game, flip over all game pieces so that the stickers do not show. Take turns with your opponent flipping over the pieces, two at a time, to try to find two matching stickers. If you find a matching pair, pick them up and place them near you. If you find a pair that does not match, flip the game pieces back over again so you cannot see the stickers. Take turns until all the matches have been found. The person who finds the most matches wins!
